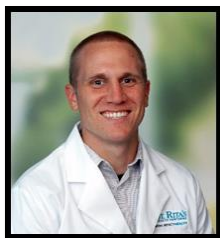


# St. Rita's Medical Center Podiatric Medicine & Surgery Residents 2018 – 2019

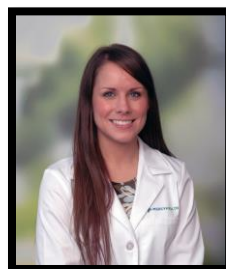

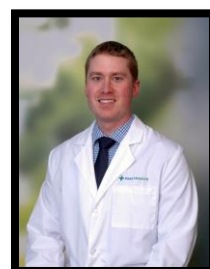
