- Registration is not complete until enrollment packet has been submitted.

PAYMENTS AND REFUNDS

- · Listed costs are per camp, per child.
- · Get 15% off all camps registered and paid in full by May 1, 2020.
- · A completed registration form, camper information packet and payment must be received before the child is officially enrolled in camp.
- · You may register with a \$50 nonrefundable/non-transferable deposit per child per week of camp. The remaining balance will be charged to your card on file every Thursday prior to the chosen camp start date.
- · Deposit is lost if registration changes are required. If paid in full, the remaining balance can be transferred or refunded if the request is made by the Thursday prior to the start of camp.
- There is a \$35 fee for returned checks.
