You may receive separate bills from your personal physician, surgeon, pathologist or other healthcare professional.

To make a payment by telephone, please call 1-855-732-0138 and do the following:

- Make a payment on your account using a check or credit card.
- Request an itemized statement.
- Provide insurance information.
- Update your address and telephone number.
- Obtain information on our financial assistance programs and more.

You can also make a payment online using our convenient and secure online bill pay system.

If you have specific questions about your account, our Customer Service Representatives are available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. We also offer a 24-hour automated customer service line and Spanish-speaking representatives.

We repeatedly offer patients access to financial help during their hospital stay and after, as well as with each billing notice. We do not charge interest to patients on their bills. We send bills to collection as a last resort, only:

- When patients have the ability to pay some portion of their healthcare expenses but refuse to do so.
- When patients refuse to work with us to determine if they qualify for free or discounted care via federal, state, local or hospital assistance programs.
- When we are unable to locate the patient or the person responsible for the bill.
